TOMORROW I RISE AGAIN

The artist's brilliant and unique career, which began back in 2003, continues with an exhibition in Milan entitled 'Gesù ti ama' (*Jesus loves you*), followed by a Christmas Eve performance entitled 'Processione di S.Nicola nelle gallerie italiane' (*St. Nicholas' procession to the galleries of Italy*), and culminating last year with an exhibition in Bergamo inaugurated on December 13, entitled 'Anche S.Lucia mi ama' (*Saint Lucy loves me too*). He won first prize in the photography category at the Em'arte 2008 Competition and is presenting a performance on Saturday, April 11th (vernissage 5 p.m.). The artist is Alberto Magrin, born in Rapallo and educated at the Faculty of Architecture in Genoa. He's received various awards and has participated in numerous collective and personal exhibitions throughout Italy as well as abroad. His works can be found in various important collections and museums, in cities like London, Madrid, Dresden, Lyon, Pittsburgh, Amsterdam and Trento.

The spirituality of art is the central focus of Magrin's vision. His works begin with snapshots dictated by 'coincidences', which are not, in fact, simple coincidences at all, and are then translated to reflect the wide-reaching spectrum of interior life. They then move on to reflect a slight irony and love, which can be understood as a dispassionate declaration to a light-hearted review of the sacred and the transcendent in the randomness of everyday life.
