

I REBORN TOMORROW

The artist continues his initiatory journey begun in 2003 at Milan's Galleria Spazio Farini 6 with his exhibition entitled 'Gesù mi ama' (*Jesus loves me*), followed in 2004 in Genoa with 'Genova capitale della cultura 2004 A.C.' (*Genoa - the Capital of Culture 2004 b.C.*), in which the artist impersonated the Fisher King, fishing the passersby off the street from the rounded niche of an 18th century building. In 2004, during the Christmas season, he brought works of art to be donated to the Italian galleries of Minini, De Carlo, Mudima, Lia Rumma, and more, with the 'Processione di S.Nicola nelle gallerie italiane' (*St. Nicholas' procession to galleries of Italy*). And the following year, after having won an international competition, he stood at the window of the Satura Galley, fishing from a glass of the 'divine'. We encountered him once again in Bergamo in 2008, on Saint Lucy's Day (December, 13), with a solo exhibition entitled 'Anche Santa Lucia mi ama' (*Saint Lucy loves me too*). This year, after having won yet another international competition at the Eco-museum of Castellina Marittima, on the day before Easter he presented his performance entitled 'Domani risorgo' (*Tomorrow I rise again*), which consisted in the artist not showing up at the event, thus representing Christ's disappearance when he was recognized by the Apostles. On Christmas Eve of this year, in Scandiano (in the province of Reggio Emilia), he presented his performance entitled 'Domani rinasco' (*I reborn tomorrow*), in which the artist was depicted fishing the wishes of mankind. All that's left for you to do is make a wish.
